

LEGISLATIVE PROPOSAL

PROPOSAL NO. B1

Present Section:

ASUSBC Bylaws:

Article V, Board of Directors – Management

Section B, Eligibility

1. Director – Eligibility – Requirements:
 - A. Candidate may only seek nomination from the association where they obtain their USBC membership. No more than 2 adult directors from the same Local USBC Association may serve at the same time.
 - B. If elected director submits their USBC membership in another association outside the association they were elected and their new association already has 2 directors serving, they may continue to serve the remainder of their term in the association they were elected.

Proposal:

Change: “2 to 3 “

If adopted, Article V, Section B will state:

1. Director – Eligibility – Requirements:
 - A. Candidate may only seek nomination from the association where they obtain their USBC membership. No more than 3 adult directors from the same Local USBC Association may serve at the same time.
 - B. If elected director submits their USBC membership in another association outside the association they were elected and their new association already has 3 directors serving, they may continue to serve the remainder of their term in the association they were elected.

Reason:

The current structure limits the board from including qualified candidates due to the number of occupants already on the board. This helps fill vacant positions with individuals that would like to be on the state board.
