

ASUSBC BY-LAWS PROPOSAL

PRESENT BYLAW...

Arkansas State USBC Bylaws
Article VI Officers
Section B. Election

Additional eligibility requirements, if any, are to be approved by the board and delegates.

1. Officers-Eligibility-Requirements:

- A. Must have served as a state director or association manager for a minimum of 3 years. A term as an officer cannot be concurrent with the position of State Association Manager .
- B. Must be a member of the Arkansas State USBC Association.
- C. No more than **1 officer** from the same Local USBC Association may serve at the same time.
- D. Candidate must become a Registered Volunteer if elected.

2. Definition of Local USBC Association – Association where a USBC membership is obtained.

PROPOSAL...

Remove the words “**1 officer**” from eligibility requirement C and replace with the words “**2 officers**”

If adopted Article VI, Section B will state:

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1. Officers-Eligibility-Requirements:

- A. Must have served as a state director or association manager for a minimum of 3 years. A term as an officer cannot be concurrent with the position of State Association Manager .
- B. Must be a member of the Arkansas State USBC Association.
- C. No more than **2 officers** from the same Local USBC Association may serve at the same time.
- D. Candidate must become a Registered Volunteer if elected.

2. Definition of Local USBC Association – Association where a USBC membership is obtained.

REASON FOR PROPOSAL...

In order to run for or be appointed to an officer position you must have served a full term on the state board or one of the previous boards. With the limited number of people this allows for this limits the candidates we have to change from to fill an officer position and could potentially leave an office vacant due to the lack of a qualified person. By changing this from 1 to 2 people this will prevent qualified applicants from switching their membership base, allow for more of an opportunity to fill the board positions and allow for better advancement on the board for more people.
