TOURNAMENT RULES

The ASUSBC Masters & Queens Tournament is an individual competition based on total pin fall and is conducted on a scratch basis. This tournament is open to male, female and youth Arkansas USBC members in good standing with a current minimum 12 game Arkansas league average. PWBA/PBA card holders will be allowed to compete. Any PBA/PWBA—Regional or National title holders in the last 2 seasons will not be allowed to enter. Youth are eligible to bowl with prize money going into their SMART account.

LIMITED TO FIRST 72 PAID ENTRIES —52 MEN / 20 WOMEN

1. Entry Fee \$150.00. (Prize Fund \$100.00, Lineage \$45.00, Expense Fee \$5.00). Prize fund returned 100%.
If paid via VENMO to Arkansas State USBC, the fee is \$155.00.
2. Check in will begin at 9:00am. Practice will begin at 9:50am, scoring at 10:00am.
3. If a bowler is not present at the scheduled competition time, an alternate bowler will be given the opportunity to bowl. A waiting list will be set up once the tournament is full. Should the tournament not receive 20 women's entries, the spots will open to any additional bowlers on the waiting list for the Masters division. NO SHOWS will not be refunded.
4. Lane Assignments and Rotation- Bowlers will draw for starting lane and position at check in. Bowlers will move after each game as indicated on the recap sheet for each bowler.
5. The top 8 men and 4 women will advance into a single elimination bracket with 2 game total pin matches. We will pay 1:3 from qualifying.
6. If there is a tie in qualifying, for advancement, a 9th & 10th frames will be bowled. Total pins will determine winner. If there is a tie for bracket seating, the high game will be the higher seed.
7. A sport pattern will be used in competition and will be announced prior to the tournament on our Facebook Page, Arkansas State USBC, and our website, www.arkansasstateusbc.com.
7. Dress Code: Proper dress code will be followed, please see arkansasstateusbc.com.
8. An entrant may be disqualified for the following during the tournament:
 - A. An infraction of the rules
 - B. Conduct derogatory to the best interest of the tournament.
 - C. Use of foreign substance which comes in contact with the approachAny infraction of the rules will be cause of immediate disqualification and removal from the tournament. Disqualification will result in forfeiture of entry fee and prize money.
9. Tournament Staff shall have the authority to decide any matters pertaining to the operation of this event not addressed in above rules. All decisions of Tournament Staff are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC rule 329.
10. Any rules not covered above, USBC rules will prevail. Protests concerning scores while the game is in progress shall be reported to Tournament Staff immediately and play shall cease until determination is made. The ASUSBC Board of Directors shall have the power to hear and act on all protests arising from or under construction of these rules.
11. Brackets and other side action will be available to all adult participants. Youth bowlers will be able to participate in brackets. CASH ONLY for brackets and side action. Bracket action for youth will be paid to their SMART Account.
