ARKANSAS SCRATCH CLASSIC JR GOLD QUALIFIER RULES:

1. This event is open to all USBC Jr Gold Members. 2025-2026 Memberships may be purchased on site for U12: \$25, for U14: \$40, and for U16/U18: \$50.
2. USBC rules and regulations will govern this event. The USBC youth code of ethics shall prevail. No smoking or any form of tobacco or E-cigs will be permitted during competition.
3. Event cost is \$80.00 per bowler broken down as follows: \$30.00 Lineage, \$46.00 Awards/Jr Gold Entries and \$4.00 expense. Personal checks will be accepted. Credit card payments will be accepted with an additional processing fee.
4. This event is limited to the first 72 paid entries. Onsite entries will be accepted if space allows.
5. Each bowler will bowl 6 games of qualifying with total pin fall on a sport pattern determining the winners by division. Lane skip pattern will be announced the day of the event with social distance guidelines influencing the decision. Each bowler will bowl no more than 3 games on the same pair.
6. Scholarship funds will be awarded 1:5 entries per division, major fraction thereof. Any ties in scholarship positions will result in the affected scholarships to be combined and divided between the recipients who will remain tied.
7. Jr Gold spots will be awarded 1:4 per division, major fraction thereof. Combining age divisions if less than 4 bowlers per division will be at the discretion of the tournament management. All bowlers will count towards awarding Jr Gold spots even if a bowler has already earned an entry into the 2026 Jr Gold Tournament.
8. In case of position ties in any division that advances to the Jr Gold Tournament, the advancer will be the bowler with the highest individual game bowled in this event. In case of a highest game tie, utilize the next highest game until the tie is broken.
9. Divisions for scholarships and Jr Gold qualifying are U12 Boy/U12 Girl, U14 Boy/U14 Girl, U16 Boy/U16 Girl, and U18 Boy/U18 Girl.
10. \$5.00 Scratch brackets will run games 1-3 and 4-6 with funds going to the winners' SMART accounts. Payout for a full bracket will be \$25.00 for first and \$15.00 for second.
11. Bowling ball alterations will be permitted during practice only. No changes to ball surface once tournament scoring begin. All bowling balls must meet USBC guidelines regarding extra holes and etching for those that do not use a thumb.
12. **Dress code will be strictly enforced. All entrants must be in appropriate bowling attire at the time they check in. Collared shirt/jersey is required. Name on the back is greatly encouraged but not required. Slacks and khakis are allowed. Skirts and skorts are allowed for female participants but must be at least fingertip length. No jeans, denim, sweats, shorts, headgear or sunglasses. You will be asked to change if this code is violated. Participants are not allowed to use electronics during competition. Any exceptions must be accompanied by medical documentation and is at the discretion of tournament management.**
13. Venmo payments will be accepted with a 2% fee. There will be a \$25 returned check fee that must be paid before you will be allowed to bowl.
