Tournament Rules

1. This tournament is open to all adult USBC Members. The tournament will be certified by USBC.
2. This will be a two-day event scheduled for September 19 and 20, 2026 with squads at 9AM, 11AM and 2:00 PM. The house will re-oil before the 2PM squad. Check-in will begin at 8:15 AM, 10:15 AM and 1:15 PM. The tournament will be held at Thunder Rolls, Pine Bluff AR.
3. Entries must be received no later than September 17, 2026. The Arkansas State USBC will not be responsible for entries lost in the mail. Re-entries will be accepted as lanes allow.
4. There will be 3 handicap doubles divisions, **Men's only, Women's only and Mixed each having their own prize fund**. There will be 4 singles divisions, Men's Handicap, Men's Scratch, Women's Handicap and Women's Scratch. You are allowed to enter both Scratch and Handicap Singles.
5. Handicap and scratch bracket will be offered to all bowlers on each squad. In addition we will offer a Virtual Alibi doubles event which will be a separate prize fund from the main tournament. Cost is \$10 per bowler/\$20 per team. A bowler can bowl with as many different bowlers on the same squad, with your doubles score being counted toward the virtual side event. Cash is preferred for all side post and sign up will be taken on site at check in.
6. This is a doubles handicap event. Tournament format requires bowling a three (3) game series. All games will be bowled on the same pair lanes. Bowlers will be allowed to bowl all 6 squads. In the main doubles event you will only be allowed to cash 1 time with the same partner. Prizes will be awarded in each division with a prize ratio of at least 1:5
7. Handicaps will be based on the bowler's highest 21 game or more final certified league average from the 2025-2026 season. If no average for the 2025-2026 season 25-26 Summer season average of 21 games of more will be used. If you do not have a 25-26 book or summer average a 26-27 current season average of 21 games of more will be used. If none of these apply the bowler will bowl scratch. Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 230. Anyone not having an established average or failing to provide verification will have to bowl scratch. Tournament director reserves the right to re-rate a bowler if deemed necessary. Bowlers participating in either a sport/challenge league shall have their averages adjusted using the USBC sport or challenge average adjustment scale. If a bowler has both a standard and sport bowling average, the higher of the standard or adjusted sport/challenge average will be used. Any rule not covered will be decided by the tournament director. Appeals or protests must be filed in writing within 72 hours.
8. Bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Frames may not be made-up. A bowler not present to bowl when it's their turn will be credited with a zero for that frame. All rules not listed herein will be in accordance with USBC rules and regulations.
9. Venmo payments will be accepted with a 2% fee. If your check is returned all entry and \$25 return check fee must be paid in cash before the bowler will be allowed to compete.

Check-in will be at 8:15 AM, 10:15 AM and 1:15 PM, start scoring at 9:00 AM, 11:00 AM and 2:00 PM
